

Our statement on Xinjiang, China:

Stitch Fix is committed to ethical and responsible sourcing. As detailed in our [Vendor Code of Conduct](#), we take human rights and labor issues incredibly seriously, and have a zero tolerance policy for forced labor in our supply chain.

The reports of forced labor and human rights abuses against Uyghurs and other ethnic minorities in Xinjiang, China are deeply concerning. We are committed to working with our industry partners including organizations like the American Apparel & Footwear Association to understand, evaluate and help address this critical global issue.

Stitch Fix does not have any factories approved for production in the Xinjiang Uyghur Autonomous Region (XUAR), and we do not knowingly source raw materials such as cotton or finished goods from XUAR.

We conduct ongoing due diligence to identify and assess potential forced labor risks related to the employment of Uyghurs and other ethnic minorities from XUAR, and have found no evidence of employment of Uyghurs or other ethnic minorities from XUAR in our supply chain.
